Labor lawyers and trade unionists from South, Central & North America will join our Cuban counterparts in the three-day international conference organized by the Cuban Society for Labor Law and Social Security of the National Union of Jurists, the Ibero-American Association of Labor Law and Social Security, the Association of American Jurists (AAJ) and the Latin American Association of Labor Lawyers (ALAL), the progressive inter-hemispheric bar associations with which the NLG and its Labor and Employment Committee are affiliated. The conference will focus on:

- \* Labor Law and the global economic crisis;
- \* Social Security: Experiences and prospects of the pension system.
- \* Labor Law procedures and conflict-solving: Jurisprudence and doctrine
- \* Professional and criminal responsibility of officials in cases of work-related accidents, occupational hazards and discrimination in the workplace

We will follow up the conference with the 11th bilateral professional research program, corresponding to the themes of the conference. We will visit Cuban workplaces, and interview workers, union leaders, labor lawyers and judges. Upon our return to the U.S., we will publish a report of the results of our research.
